

FINANCIAL SECURITY STATEMENT

Trainees/ interns whose monthly stipends are less than \$1,500 per month must show evidence that they will be able to support themselves during their traineeship in the U.S. This can be done either:

1. By a statement from their bank that the personal funds available to the trainee/intern are equal to the total amount required and may be drawn upon when needed

OR

2. By a statement signed by the parents/legal guardians that they are willing to act as guarantors and will provide financial assistance to the trainee in the U.S. in case of need.

The amount required is:

Total number of months in the U.S. x \$1,500. The stipend stated in the training contract is to be subtracted from this amount in order to find the sum to be guaranteed by the bank or parents/legal guardians.

Example:

\$400	per month stipend	\$1,500	required per month
<u>x 6</u>	months of traineeship	<u>x 6</u>	months of traineeship
\$2,400		\$9,000	

$\$9,000 - \$2,400 = \$6,600$ **amount to be guaranteed**
